business, he decided to pursue his Finance background instead.

Upon finishing his degree, Jason took a sales position with an Aerospace and Defense company that allowed him to travel all over the country, even internationally. He didn't think it could get much better than this! He made fantastic money, had a large expense account, stayed in fancy hotels and flew first class most everywhere he went.

But the growing desire to do what he was created to do, began to overshadow the comfort level Jason had grown accustomed to. Most of the things that he had wanted, he now had, but there was still this emptiness.



After six years of climbing the corporate ladder, Jason realized that happiness isn't in what you can buy, or a dream job. It's in following a passion and God's calling on your life.
